Customer Objective

To provide street lighting connections as part of the replacement of circa 90 street lighting columns which were deemed obsolete by the local authority.

Project Overview

With the scheme covering the Dunscroft estate in Doncaster, Linbrooke were selected to work in collaboration with Trident Civils and the local authority to provide street lighting connections for the future build of over 90 street lighting columns.

This involved all excavation, jointing and reinstatement works to strongly facilitate the replacement of ageing stock and effectively increase and modernise the efficiency of the estate's lighting performance.

As an Independent Connections Provider (ICP) with Distribution Network Operator (DNO) authorised cable jointing teams, Linbrooke provided a full turnkey package of all excavation, cable laying, jointing, reinstatement and commissioning works.
